2. WISYS TECHNOLOGY FOUNDATION WISCONSIN SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY SYMPOSIUM

LODGING: Limited housing is available at UW-La Crosse's Reuter Hall. This is an apartment style residence hall with four individual, lockable single sleeping rooms sharing a kitchen, living room and bathroom. This hall is air conditioned and four people are housed per suite (same gender). Students from two different universities may be housed together if one university does not fill the entire suite. The cost is \$21 per person per night.

Certain restrictions do apply. Each room comes with two sheets, a pillow case, pillow and blanket. Each person will need to bring their own towels and personal hygiene items. They will also need to bring their own hangers, alarm clock and drinking glass if they want or need these things. Guests will need to agree to leave the suite in the same condition they find it in and not use the kitchen (stove/oven, sink, countertops or cabinets).
